Voting Machines

Tom and Keshia visited our precincts to determine the best number and use of voting machines

With the current rule of 250, a listing of each precinct with respective touch screens was

provided; 112 touch screens correlates to the 250, while 57 of the 142 in the

county are actually utilized at this time

Suggestion by Tom that a reasonable decision be made regarding actual need vs available

machines to achieve lower voter waiting times (board will discuss this matter later)

Discussion of mandatory machine testing

Poll pads

Poll pads presently in service will be the ones used for the November election Currently two per precinct

Tom posed question of whether new poll pads should be requested Vote by board members was 3-0 to NOT purchase new poll pads

Change of Address Postcards

Process has been completed and 251 cards have been updated

Poll workers

The county has lost 9 poll workers but 7 new workers are onboard pending drug tests, etc

Lease Agreements

Leases have been sent, 3 are pending, each is a two year lease
