New Business: Comments and clarity about reconciliation and problems with a poll pad not uploading properly due to Meraki Internet System being unconnected.

Polling sites have been renamed and corresponding sheets were provided

Tom inquired about more effective use of space at Precinct 3, Cindy clarified per Bryan Board of Education Superintendent decision

Cindy explained that nine addresses were in the wrong district during redistricting, they are now corrected and the discrepancy did not have impact upon the election

November election preparedness was addressed by Tom:

A poll workers meeting will immediately follow this board meeting to gather concerns from poll workers and optimize the voting process

Tom addressed spacing of machines to maximize facility use while retaining voter privacy. Tom has determined, after speaking with the State of Georgia officials, that no law stipulates voter spacing parameters, hence honoring voter's concerns for confidence and privacy shall be sought

Discussion of whether enough poll pads are in use, Cindy claimed that each new pad is \$1157, but may be negotiable. Budget monies for such is uncertain

Tom suggested board members and supervisors visit precincts to see if any changes are warranted

Cindy and Kathryn commented about the possibility of new workers be hired to assist in the voting process
