NEWS: Tropical Storm Idalia Update #3

BRYAN COUNTY Ga, Bryan County is under a Tropical Storm Warning and Storm Surge Watch as conditions are right for potential tropical storm force winds. The main expectation at this time is that Bryan County will be impacted by tropical storm force winds of 40-80 mph as early as noon on Wednesday August 30, 2023. Flooding in low lying areas due to storm surge is also a possibility.

Bryan County Schools are closed for Wednesday, August 30, 2023, and will reassess conditions for Thursday. Atlantic Waste will start can pickup in Bryan County earlier than normal on Wednesday, August 30, 2023. Sandbags and sand are available at the Black Creek Convenience Center, the Bryan County Public Works building on Fort McAlister Road, and the Daniel Siding Road Fire Station.
