

Bryan County Board of Commissioners – Special Called Meeting – August 23, 2021

The special called meeting of the Bryan County Board of Commissioners was held on Monday, August 23, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. in Richmond Hill. The following members were present: Chairman Carter Infinger, Commissioner Dallas Daniel, Commissioner Gene Wallace, Commissioner Wade Price and Commissioner Noah Covington. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Carter Infinger at 5:06 p.m.
