Bryan County Board of Commissioners – Pre-Agenda Meeting – June 6, 2018

The pre-agenda meeting of the Bryan County Board of Commissioners was held on Wednesday, June 6, 2018 at 4:00 p.m. in Richmond Hill. The following members were present: Chairman Carter Infinger, Commissioner Steve Myers, Commissioner Wade Price, Commissioner Noah Covington, Commissioner Rick Gardner, and Commissioner Brad Brookshire. Also present: County Administrator Ben Taylor and County Clerk Donna Waters.

Jeff Adams, Planning & Zoning Director, gave a presentation on "framing" Bryan County. Step 1 of this process would involve adopting an interim development ordinance. Step 2 of this process would involve adopting a unified development ordinance.

Kirk Croasmun, County Engineer, gave an update on several ongoing projects.

John Rauback, Finance Director, gave an update on the county finances.

Ben Taylor reviewed the agenda items with the board members and gave an update on current events.

A discussion was held on holding a **retreat** on August 15, 16 & 17, 2018 at Jekyll Island. This would be a half day on the 15th, full day on the 16th and half day of the 17th.

A discussion was held on the funding gap for the **Belfast-Keller Interchange** project. Bryan County had previously committed \$2.1 million for this project, but the bids were higher than expected. We may need to commit another \$650,000 for this project. More accurate figures will be provided at the regularly scheduled meeting next week.

A motion was made by Rick Gardner and seconded by Steve Myers to go into **executive session** to discuss real estate. Motion carried unanimously. The board went into executive session at 6:29 p.m. A motion was made by Rick Gardner and seconded by Steve Myers to go back into regular session. Motion carried unanimously. The board went back into regular session at 6:39 p.m.
